



Budweiser will spend Memorial Day weekend telling you how patriotic it is. But on Long Island, Budweiser uses Clare Rose Distributing to distribute its beers.

Clare Rose also took more than \$370,000 out of Long Island schools in 2016, as part of a long-term tax break that began in 2009. That's tax revenue that Long Island schools cannot replace.
